ADDENDUM #2

1. Will the firm awarded the Schematic Design continue through construction once funding is available? OR will another RFP be issued?
ANS: Maybe. If additional funding becomes available that can support the prioritized projects, then a contract amendment may be written for the consultant to continue through construction. However, because project priorities, schedule, and funding are unknown, it is not in the parties' best interest to enter into an ambiguous obligation.

2. Please clarify if the design team is required to have a Mechanical or Electrical engineer on the design team?
ANS: No, the design team is not required to have a Mechanical or Electrical engineer on the design team however if the consultant wishes to include engineering, it is at their discretion. The project intent does not include engineering at this time.

3. Please explain how Targeted Group/Economically Disadvantaged or Veteran-owned Firms are awarded additional point consideration.
ANS: A firm must meet both eligibility and certification requirements as determined by the Minnesota Department of Administration State Procurement office in order to be awarded additional points. ANS: Yes.

ANS: No.
